# ENABLE-TAAT

ENABLE-TAAT project is one of 15 Compacts comprising the Technologies for African Agricultural Transformation Program (TAAT), funded by the African Development Bank (AfDB) and led by the International Institute of Tropical Agriculture (IITA) through its youth in agribusiness initiative. The overall purpose of ENABLE-TAAT is to assist in the promotion of TAAT's key agricultural technologies, operate technology and innovation centers for young people on specific commodity value chains, and to stimulate youth-led agribusiness start-up in support of TAAT's nine Priority Commodity Chains. The program will expand agribusiness opportunities, provide agribusiness support, improve human nutrition and advance youth empowerment mechanisms.

### ENABLE-TAAT: An overview



The Program will operate in 19 countries across Africa in 2018



The activities of the compact cover agribusiness completion, incubation, youth advocacy, youth registration and food basket



39 'quick win' youth led agribusiness enterprises to be established in 2018



8 agribusiness incubations to be established in 8 countries-Nigeria, DRC, Benin, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, Togo and Zambia



5000 youths to be empowered in the first year of implementation of the project



Establishment of demonstration fields under the food basket outreach to promote improved nutrition

Compact Activities will be across 9 value chains: Rice, Wheat, Maize, Cassava, Sorghum and Millet, Small livestock, Fish Farming, Orange fleshed sweet potato, Iron fortified beans
